# Adobe Security Bulletin

## APSB25-15

- **Release Date:** April 8<sup>th</sup>
- **Why this was released:** This update resolves critical and important vulnerabilities that could lead to arbitrary file system read, arbitrary code execution and security feature bypass.
- **What version does this update ColdFusion to?**
  - ColdFusion 2025 – Update 1
  - ColdFusion 2023 – Update 13
  - ColdFusion 2021 – Update 19

# Prevent Your App from Breaking When the Latest ColdFusion Security Patches are Installed

These security patches to Adobe ColdFusion disable searching implicit variable scopes:

- ColdFusion 2023 - Update 7
- ColdFusion 2021 - Update 13

The purpose of this update was to resolve a critical vulnerability that could lead to arbitrary file system read.



# Prevent Your App from Breaking When the Latest ColdFusion Security Patches are Installed

**What is an implicit variable scope?**

An implicit variable scope is simply one where the variable has no scope.

Examples include:

- Form.thevariable – Form scope
- URL.theVariable – URL scope
- Application.theVariable – Application scope
- Session.theVariables – Session scope

# Prevent Your App from Breaking When the Latest ColdFusion Security Patches are Installed

How do I prevent this from breaking my application?

1. Find all of the unscoped variables in your application. If this is large legacy application, consider using Fixinator (created by Foundeo) and scope all of those variables in your application
2. Instruct ColdFusion to resume searching implicit variables scopes

*NOTE: this option will be removed in a future ColdFusion release*

```
<cfscript>  
    this.searchImplicitScopes="true";  
</cfscript>
```
